Churchly uses a combination of automated tools and human moderators to keep the platform safe, respectful, and culturally welcoming.

1. Goals of Moderation

Moderation exists to:

- Protect users from harm
- Maintain a welcoming environment
- Enforce community rules
- Remove illegal or abusive content
- Prevent spam or misuse

2. Types of Moderation

A. Automated Moderation

- Detects spam or repetitive content
- Filters harmful or restricted words
- Flags suspicious behavior

B. Human Moderation

Our team reviews:

- Reported posts or comments
- Content flagged by algorithms
- Potential violations of rules
- Harmful or sensitive discussions

Moderators are trained to be fair, consistent, and respectful.



3. Actions Moderators May Take

Moderators may:

- Remove or hide posts
- Edit content if necessary (e.g., to remove personal data)
- Issue warnings
- Disable posting privileges
- Temporarily or permanently suspend accounts
- Block harmful users
- Escalate severe cases to authorities

Moderation decisions may happen with or without user explanation.

4. Appeal Process

We will review and respond within a reasonable timeframe.

5. Moderator Conduct

Moderators must:

- Be neutral
- Not engage in disputes
- Treat all users equally
- Follow internal safety guidelines
